

THE BAND COUNCIL OF THE INDIAN BAND OF CURVE LAKE

BY-LAW NUMBER 1-75

A BY-LAW TO REGULATE FISHING

WHEREAS Section 81, subsection (o) of The Indian Act, permits the Band to pass by-laws for the preservation, protection and management of fishing; now therefore, the Council of the Band of Curve Lake enacts as follows:

- 1. That no member of the Band may fish for commercial or re-sale purposes.
- 2. The members of the Band may be permitted to fish as a food supply for themselves and members of their families only.
