

**BY-LAW NO. 14-97
of the Chippewas of Nawash First Nation**

**A BY-LAW FOR THE PRESERVATION,
PROTECTION AND MANAGEMENT OF FISH**

WHEREAS the Council of the Chippewas of Nawash First Nation has enacted a by-law governing the preservation, protection and management of fish in Band waters, matters ancillary thereto, and a penalty for the violation thereof;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Chippewas of Nawash First Nation has the power to amend such by-law pursuant to paragraph 81(q) of the Indian Act;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Chippewas of Nawash First Nation hereby amends the Chippewas of Nawash First Nation Fishing By-law 13-96 by repealing **section 26** of the said by-law and replacing it with the following section:

Penalty

- 26.** A person who commits an offence under this by-law is liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding one thousand dollars or imprisonment for a term not exceeding thirty days, or both.

This by-law is hereby made at a duly convened meeting of the Council of the Chippewas of Nawash First Nation this 7th day of March, 1997.
