REPEAL OF CERTAIN BY-LAWS

WHERE AS the Council of the BEAUSOLEIL FIRST NATION desires to repeal certain by-laws;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the BEAUSOLEIL FIRST NATION, pursuant to sections 80 and 81 of the *Indian Act*, R.S.C. 1985, c.1-5, may, subject to the approval of the Minister of Indian Affairs and Northern Development, make by-laws for any or all of the purposes provided for under sections 80 and 81;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the BEAUSOLEIL FIRST NATION did enact certain by-laws in accordance with aforesaid sections of the *Indian Act*, R.S.C. 1985, c.1-5;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the BEAUSOLEIL FIRST NATION, hereby enacts this by-law to repeal the following by-laws:

Band by-law number 1, By-law Title "WILDLIFE", enacted on the 6th day of August, 1960, effective on the 24th day of October, 1960; and

Band by-law number 2, By-law Title "WILDLIFE", enacted on the 1st day of November, 1961, effective on the 17th of November, 1961; and

Band by-law number 3, By-law Title "WILDLIFE", enacted on the 29th day of October, 1962, effective on the 8th day of November, 1962; and

Band by-law number 4, By-law Title "ANCILLARY POWERS", enacted on the 22nd day of February, 1966, effective on the 1st day of April, 1966; and

Band by-law number 5, By-law Title "TRAFFIC", enacted on the 23rd of November, 1977, effective on the 11th day of January, 1978; and

Band by-law number 5, By-law Title "TRAFFIC", enacted on the 4th day of July, 1968, effective on the 2nd day of August, 1968; and

Band by-law number 6, By-law Title "LAW AND ORDER", enacted on the 2nd day of October, 1968, effective on the 10th day of November, 1968; and

Band by-law number 7, By-law Title "LOCAL WORKS", enacted on the 13th day of November, 1969 effective on the 22nd day of December, 1969; and

Band by-law number 9, By-law Title "PUBLIC GAMES", enacted on the 10th day of August, 1971, effective on the 18th day of September, 1971; and

Band by-law unnumbered, By-law Title "Development Commission", enacted on the 15th day of June, 1971; File Reference 475/28-12; and

Band by-law number 9, By-law Title "Raising of moneys for community services", enacted on the 5th day of February, 1975, File Reference 475/3-10-5.
