

REGULATION OF TRAFFIC.

The Council of the Kettle and Stony Point Band of Indians at a meeting held on July 12th, 1956 makes the following by-law pursuant to paragraph (b) and (r) of Section 80 of the Indian Act.

By-law No. 1


A by-law to provide for the regulation of traffic in Kettle Point Indian Reserve, in the Province of Ontario.

(a) No vehicle shall be operated at a rate of speed in excess of thirty (30) miles per hour on any road within the boundaries of this Reserve.

(b) Any person who violates any of the provisions of this by-law shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding Fifty (\$50.00) Dollars and not less than Ten (\$10.00) Dollars or imprisonment for a term not exceeding ten (10) days, or both fine and imprisonment.
