REGULATION OF TRAFFIC.

The Council of the Kettle and Stony Point Band of Indians at a meeting held on July 12th, 1956 makes the following by-law pursuant to paragraph (b) and (r) of Section 80 of the Indian Act.

By-law No. 1

A by-law to provide for the regulation of traffic in Kettle Point Indian Reserve, in the Province of Ontario.

- (a) No vehicle shall be operated at a rate of speed in excess of thirty (30) miles per hour on any road within the boundaries of this Reserve.
- (b) Any person who violates any of the provisions of this by-law shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding Fifty (\$50.00) Dollars and not less than Ten (\$10.00) Dollars or imprisonment for a term not exceeding ten (10) days, or both fine and imprisonment.
