Kettle Point Band of Indians  
By-Law No ~~14~~  
11

WHEREAS by virtue of Section 80 of the Indian Act, R. S. C., 1952 Chapter 149 the Council of the Kettle Point Band of Indians is empowered to make Bylaws with respect to the observance of law and order and the prevention of disorderly conduct and nuisances.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED as a Bylaw of the Council of the Kettle Point Band of Indians as follows:

1. No person shall be engaged in conduct on Kettle Point of such a nature as to be disorderly or disturbing to the residents of Kettle Point or to create a nuisance for such residents or any of them.
2. No person shall do any illegal act which may result in destruction of/or damage to property, real or personal, on Kettle Point.
3. Any person violating this Bylaw shall be guilty of an offence and on summary conviction may be sentenced to a fine not exceeding \$100.00 or to imprisonment for a term not exceeding thirty (30) days, or to both fine and imprisonment.
4. Any person giving information to the Council of the Kettle Point Band of Indians or any employee thereof, which results in the conviction of any person of an offence under this Bylaw, shall be eligible to a reward in such sum not exceeding Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) as may be fixed by the
