DO HEMSBY RESOLVE:

That we enact the following By-law under Section 80 (b) of the Indian Act, By-law #8-A for the regulation and control of bicycles on the Kettle Point Indian Reserve. In view of the increasing number of bicycles on the Kettle Point Indian Reserve all owners and operators will be required to obtain a bicycle licence beginning May 1st, 1968. Licence to be supplied by the Band Council at no cost to the applicant. The issue and control of licences to be under the control of the Kettle Point Indian Reserve Special Constable. At the time of licencing and thereafter all bicycles are to be equipped with lights or reflectors front and rear to render the bicycle visible at a minimum distance of 200 feet, at any time. When this By-law 8-A becomes effective it rescinds By-law #8 dated September 13th, 1966.
