This will refer to your 163/3-10-19 of April 7, 1960, concerning a by-law proposed by the Stellaquo Band to provide for the preservation, protection and management of fur-bearing animals, fish and game on the Stellaquo Indian Reserve No. 5.

This by-law has now been approved by the Minister and I enclose herewith a photo copy of the Minister's order of approval.

With reference to your inquiry concerning the enforcement of the by-law I would advise you that the R.C.M. Police have agreed to assist in the enforcement of this type of by-law.
