The Council of the Hydrey Indian Band at a meeting held this day vote the following by-law pursuant to paragraphs (c) and (1) of s. 10 of the Indian Act.

By-law No. 6

For the purpose of the maintenance of law and order and for the prevention of disorderly conduct and nuisance in the Hydrey Indian Reserve in the Province of Nova Scotia.

- In this by-law, the words "shall" includes any class to which the public have access as: (a) invited or by invitation express or implied.
- The person shall cause a disturbance in or near a public place.

DO HEREBY RESOLVE:

- No person shall disturb the peace and quiet of the occupants of a dwelling house by discharging fire-arms, or by other disorderly conduct in a public place, or dwelling house.
- No person shall without lawful excuse, the proof of which lies upon him, prowl or loiter by day or by night upon the property of another person near a dwelling house situated on that property without the owner's permission either express or implied.
- Any person who violates any provision of this by-law shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding \$100.00 or imprisonment for a term not exceeding 30 days or both fine and imprisonment.
