The Council of the Reset Fend of Indians at a meeting held Musset Indian Reserve Mo. I, December 10th, 1957, malice the following bylaw pursuant to naraerechs (k) and (r) of Section 80 of the Indian Act.

By -lev: No. 5
A by-law to provide for the regulation of traffic in Musset lo. I Indian Reserve, in the Province of Eritish Columbia.
(a)

No vehicle, except fire trucks or passenger vehicles carrying firefighters to the scene of a fire, shall be operated at a rate of speed in excess of fifteen miles an hour within any resideential area designated and marked as such by the Council of the Band. (b)

Mo vehicle, except fire trucks or passenger vehicles carr ing firefighters to the scene of a fire, shall be operated over say bridge within the asset No. I Indian Reserve at a rate of speed in excess of the speed designated and merged thereon by the Counail of the Banc.
(c)

Any person who violeter ry of the provisions of this bylaw shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine rot exceeding one hundred dollars or imprisonmont for a term not exceeding thirty days, or both fine and imprison mont. •
