The Council of the Masset Band of Indians at a meeting held Masset Indian Reserve No. 1, December 10th, 1957, makes the following by-law pursuant to paragraphs (b) and (r) of Section 80 of the Indian Act.

By-law No. 5

A by-law to provide for the regulation of traffic in Masset No. 1 Indian Reserve, in the Province of British Columbia.

(a) No vehicle, except fire trucks or passenger vehicles carrying fire-fighters to the scene of a fire, shall be operated at a rate of speed in excess of fifteen miles an hour within any residential area designated and marked as such by the Council of the Band.

(b) No vehicle, except fire trucks or passenger vehicles carrying fire-fighters to the scene of a fire, shall be operated over any bridge within the Masset No. 1 Indian Reserve at a rate of speed in excess of the speed designated and marked thereon by the Council of the Band.

(c) Any person who violates any of the provisions of this by-law shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding one hundred dollars or imprisonment for a term not exceeding thirty days, or both fine and imprisonment.
