DO HEREBY RESOLVE:

A bylaw to provide for the regulation of traffic in Masset Indian Reserve, in the Province of British Columbia. By-law No. 1.

(a) No vehicle shall be operated at a rate of speed in excess of fifteen miles an hour within any residential area designated and marked as such by the council of the band.

(b) No vehicle shall be operated over any bridge within the Masset Indian Reserve at a rate of speed in excess of the speed designated and marked thereon by the council of the band.

(c) Any person who violates any of the provisions of this bylaw shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding ten dollars or imprisonment for a term not exceeding seven days, or both fine and imprisonment.
