THE OWEEKENO BAND OF INDIANS

BY-LAW NO. 1

Being a By-law to provide for the regulation of the discharge of firearms.

Whereas Paragraphs (c), (d) and (r) of Section 81 of the Indian Act empower the Council of a Band to make By-laws respecting the observation of law and order, the prevention of disorderly conduct and nuisances, and the imposition of a penalty for the violation thereof;

And Whereas it is deemed to be expedient to control the discharge of firearms within the boundaries of Kalit I.R. #1, Kiltala I.R. #2 and Cockmi I.R. #3 for the safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the residents thereof:

Now Therefore the Council of the Oweekeno Band of Indians enacts as a By-Law thereof the following:

1. In this By-law:

- (a) "Council" means the Council, as defined in the Indian Act, of the Oweekeno Band of Indians;
