

The Council of the Bella Coola Band of
Indians at a meeting held November 29, 1965 (date)
makes the following by-law pursuant to paragraph (b) and (r) of Section
80 of the Indian Act.

By-law No. 12

A by-law to provide for the regulation of traffic in Bella
Coola #1 Indian Reserve, in the Pro-
vince of British Columbia.

- (a) No vehicle shall be operated at a rate of speed in excess
of 30 miles an hour within any residential area
designated and marked as such by the Council of the Band.
- (b) No vehicle shall be operated over any bridge within the
Bella Coola #1 Indian Reserve at a rate
of speed in excess of the speed designated and marked
thereon by the Council of the Band.
- (c) Any person who violates any of the provisions of this
by-law shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable
on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding one hundred
dollars or imprisonment for a term not exceeding thirty
days, or both fine and imprisonment.
