THE KINCOLITH BAND OF INDIANS

BY-LAW NUMBER 2

Being a BY-LAW to provide for the regulation of the use of Public Wells, Cisterns, Reserviors and other water supplies.

The Council of the Kincolith Band of Indians at a meeting held at Kincolith B.C. on the Seventh day of April, 1988, makes the following by-law pursuant to paragraph (i) and (a) of Section 81 of the Indian Act.

- (a) No person shall willfully or maliciously pollute any public well, cistern, reservoir or other water supply within the Kincolith Indian Reserve, in the Province of British Columbia.
- (b) No person shall under the influence of intoxicants, enter or destroy, or injure any public well, cistern, reservoir or other water supply within the reserve.
- (c) The holder of a certificate of possession, or occupant of land within the reserve, shall keep any well thereon properly enclosed or covered.
- (d) Any person who violates any of the provisions of this by-law shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding \$250.00 or imprisonment for a term not exceeding seven days, or both, fine and imprisonment.
