- (2) By-Law #002. Pursuant to pa ragraph "E" of Sec. "80" of the Indian Act.
 - (a) A Dog Regulations' Officer means: A person appointed by the Band Council.
- (b) Every person who is the owner, possessor or harbourer of a dog over the age of six (6) months is required to procure an annual license for his dog. With the consent of the Dog Regulations' Officer, the head of each family or persons living alone may keep one male dog or one spayed female dog, upon presentation of a certificate as proof of spaying, free of tax, provided that registration of such dog is made in accordance with the regulations.
- (c) The fee for each additional male dog or spayed female dog is \$3.50 and the fee for each unapayed female dog is \$10.00. These licenses are due and payable on January lat of each year. If the license fee is not paid by February lat of each year, a penalty of \$1.75 is added. (As a result of a reference of the past year's license but does not pertain to newly acquired dogs).
- (d) Dogs are not allowed to run at large on the Musqueem Reserve which means elsewhere than on the premises of a person cwning, or having custody, care or control of any dog and not being under the immediate charge and control of a responsible and competent person.
- (e) If an unlicensed dog is off his owner's property and not under the immediate charge of a responsible person, it will be impounded and destroyed by the Dog Regulation Officer. (continued)
