(2) BroLay tione Pursuant to pa ragraph "E" of sec. " 80 " of the Indian ACts
(a) A Dog Fegulations' Oificer meanss A person appointed by the Band Council.
(b) Every person who is the owner, possessor or harbourer of a dog over the age of $1 \times$ ( 6 ) montha is required to procure on annuel ilcenge for his dog. With the consent of the Dog Kegulations' Officer, the head of each family or persons living alone may keep one male dog or one spayed female dog, upon preaentation of certifioate as proof of spaying. free of tax, provided that registration of such dog is made in accordance with the regulations.
(c) The foe for each additional male dog or spayed female dog is 53.50 and the fee for each unspayed female dog is $\$ 10,00$. These licenses are due and payable on January lat of each year. If the license fee is not paid by february lat of each year, a penalty of $\$ 1.75$ is added. (As a result of a reference of the past year's license but does not pertain to nevly acquired doga).
(d) Dogs are not allowad to run at large on the Musqueam Reserve which means elsewhere than on the premises of a person owning, or having oustody, care or control of any dog and not being under the immediate charge and control of a responsible and/competent person.
(e) If an unlicensed dog is off his owner's property and not under the immediate charge of a responsible pergon, it will be impounded and destroyed by the Dog Regulation Officer.
