

The Council of the Pemberton Band of
Indians at a meeting held October tenth, 1954
makes the following bylaw pursuant to paragraph (b) and (r) of
Section 80 of The Indian Act.

Bylaw No. _____

A bylaw to provide for the regulation of traffic in _____
Pemberton Indian Reserve, in the Province of British
Columbia.

(a) No vehicle shall be operated at a rate of speed in excess
fifteen
of ~~thirty~~ miles an hour within any residential area designated
and marked as such by the council of the band.

(b) No vehicle shall be operated over any bridge within the
Pemberton Indian Reserve at a rate of speed in
excess of the speed designated and marked thereon by the council
of the band.

(c) Any person who violates any of the provisions of this by-
law shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable on summary
conviction to a fine not exceeding ten dollars or imprisonment
for a term not exceeding seven days, or both fine and imprisonment.
