The Council of the Kispion Band of Indians at a meeting held at the Kispiox Indian Reserve No. 1 makes the following by-law pursuant to paragraph (a) and (r) of Section 80 of the Indian Act and as provided under by-law No. 8, part c.

## - may 10, 1958 By-law No. 9.

A by-law to provide for the removal of garbage and waste on the Kispiox Indian Reserve in the Province of British Columbia.

- (a) Every householder shall deposit all garbage and waste in a fly proof receptical provided with a water tight cover.
- (b) No water or liquids shall be placed in or allowed to runk into or accumulate in any receptical.
- The receptical shall be placed at the street or alley by (c) 9:00 a.m. standard time, on the day designated for garbage collection.
- The garbage shall be collected twice monthly at such time as designated by the council.
- For the collection of garbage and waste a fee in the (e) amount as set hereunder shall be imposed and levied. \$1900 per month.
- (f) Accounts shall be paid to the person delegated by the Council.
- Accounts are to be paid by the 15th day of the current (g) month.
- Any person who violates any of the provisions of this (b)by-lay shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable on sw mary conviction to a fine not exceeding ten dollars (\$10.00) or imprisonment for a term not exceeding seven (7) days, or both fine and imprisonment.
