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DO HEREBY RESOLVE:

WHEREAS the Council of the Chippewas of the Sarnia Band deems it expedient that a By-law should be passed to provide for the demolition of such buildings situate on the Reserve as constitute a hazard for public safety.

AND WHEREAS Section 80 of The Indian Act, R.S.C. 1950, Chapter 149 as amended, provides that the Council may pass such By-laws as are therein provided.

NOW THEREFORE, this Council enacts as a By-law as follows:

Authorized Officer

- 1. The Council, or its duly appointed representative, may declare that any building, structure or other erection situate on the Sarnia Reserve constitutes a hazard to the safety of the residents of the Reserve.
- 2. The Council or its duly appointed representative shall by notice in writing to the person or persons owning such building, structure or other erection, advise such person or persons that any such building must be demolished and removed within 30 days of the service of such notice.
- 3. Any person or persons who fail to abide by the terms of any such notice shall be liable to the imposition, on summary conviction, of a fine not exceeding \$100.00 or imprisonment for a term not exceeding 30 days or both fine and imprisonment for violation of this By-law.
- 4. This By-law shall come into force 40 days after a copy hereof is forwarded to The Minister of Indian Affairs and Northern Development in accordance with Section 81 of The Indian Act.
