A BY-LAW RESPECTING FARM & EXOTIC ANIMAL**Part 1- General**

1. For the purpose of this bylaw
 (a) Domestic Fowl means chickens, capons turkeys ducks, geese
 (b) Farm Animals mean cows, pigs, sheep, goats

Part 2 - Keeping of Rabbits, Pigeon & Domestic Fowl

The keeping of bantam or miniature chickens, pigeons and rabbits within the Chippewas of Sarnia shall be subject to the following general and special condition :

- (1) All are to be kept in suitable cages, pens encloses Lofts Or Rabbitries
- (2) Any Building or structure used or intended for use for the above shall be :
- (i) Must contain two acres of property situate in the centre of property
 - (ii) Distant at least three meters (3M) from all lot lines
 - (iii) Distant at least ten meter (10 m) from any church , school , dwelling or other premises used for human habitation
 - (iv) The inside walls and ceiling (if) of such building or structure shall be painted or lime washed at least once per year
 - (v) Kept at all times in a clean and sanitary condition , free from refuse odour flies and vermin
- (3) All feed shall be stored in air tight , rodent proof containers except for straw or hay
- (4) All droppings, refuse and dropped or scattered feed shall be disposed of in a sanitary manner and kept until disposed of in substantial air tight containers

Part 3 - Special Conditions

- (1) With respect to bantam or miniature chickens a maximum of twelve (12) may be kept on any lands or premises provided that they are kept indoors in suitable pens cages or structure have no outside pens or runs
- (2) With respect to pigeon a maximum of twenty five (25) pair may be kept on any lands or premises
- (3) With respect to rabbits a maximum of twenty (20) rabbits may be kept on any lands or premises
- (4) With respect to turkeys a maximum of two (2) may be kept on any lands or premises
- (5) With respect to ducks a maximum of four (4) may be kept on any lands or premises
- (6) With respect to geese a maximum of four (4) may be kept on any lands or premises
- (7) Notwithstanding the following special provisions any young born to such birds or animals may be kept for a period not exceeding sixteen (16) weeks after birth or hatching and will not, for that time period be count toward the maximum

Part 4 - RESTRICTED ANIMALS

(1) Except as provided in Part - 4 section 2 This By- Law the keeping of certain Animals as set out in schedule "A" of this by law is hereby prohibited anywhere on Chippewa Of Sarnia

(2) Notwithstanding with Part - 4 section (1¹) of this By -Law any person who owned an animal set out in schedule "A" prior to May 15 of 2001 may be permitted to keep the animal , if the animal is registered in the band office and if the animal control office is satisfied that the animal is being kept in a humane manner and that adequate precaution are being taken to ensure that the animal cannot escape or in any way pose a danger to the public

SCHEDULE "A"

Exotic Animal : Alligators, Crocodiles, Jaguars , Leopards, Lions Lynx, Tigers Bobcats
Anaconda, Python, Boa Constrictors & Venomous Snakes Of Any Kind

Farm Animal: Cows, Pigs, Sheep, Lambs, Goats
