The Council of the <u>Hartley Bay</u> Eand of Indians at a meeting held <u>January 10th, 1956 at Prince Rupert, B.C.</u> rakes the following bylaw pursuant to paragraph (a)(ii) of subsection one of section 82, and paragraph (r) of section 80 of The Indian Act.

Fylaw Yo. 7

A tylaw to provide for the licencing of businesses, callings, trades and occupations within the Kulkayu #4A Indian Reserve, in the Province of Pritish Columbia

- (a) No person shall conduct or carry on any business, calling, trade or occupation as listed herein who is not the holder of a valid and subsisting licence for the business, calling, trade or occupation issued pursuent to this bylaw.
- (b) There shall be raid at the time of the application for a licence a fee in the amount as set out hereunder, which licence may be renewed from year to year upon payment of the required fee.

(c) Any person who violates any of the provisions of this bylaw shall be quilty of an offence and shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding __050.00 _____ dollars or imprisonment for a term not exceeding __forteen days ______, or both fine and imprisonment.
