



The Council of the Kitwanoool Band of  
Indians at a meeting held 23rd. May 1957 A.D.  
makes the following bylaw pursuant to paragraph (b) and (r) of section 80  
of The Indian Act.

Bylaw No. 8.

A bylaw to provide for the regulation of traffic in Kitwanoool  
Indian Reserve, in the Province of British  
Columbia.

- (a) No vehicle shall be operated at a rate of speed in excess  
of 20 miles an hour within any residential area designated  
and marked as such by the council of the band.
- (b) No vehicle shall be operated over any bridge within the \_\_\_\_\_  
Kitwanoool Indian Reserve at a rate of speed in excess  
of the speed designated and marked thereon by the council of the Band.
- (c) Any person who violates any of the provisions of this bylaw shall  
be guilty of an offence and shall be liable on summary conviction to  
a fine not exceeding ten dollars or imprisonment for a term not exce-  
eding seven days, or both fine and imprisonment.
