(b)	Every toilet or privy shall be not less than 25 feet	from	
	any well or water supply.		
(c)	Such toilet or privy shall be of fly proof construction ar	nd shall	
	be provided with a tight fitting door which shall be kept	closed.	
(d)	All toilets or privies shall be kept in a clean and sanita	ry	
	condition.		
(e)	The council may arrange for the regular removal of nig	ht-soil	
	from any premises within the reserve.		
(f)	Night-soil from privies kept on premises pending remo	val	
	therefrom shall be kept in a water tight, fly proof cover	red	
	container.
