The Council of the Lytton Band, at a meeting held on October 22nd, 1963, makes the following by-law pursuant to paragraph (1) and paragraph (r) of Section 80 of the Indian Act.

By-law No. 2

A by-law to provide for the regulation of domestic water supplies on Lytton Indian Reserves.

- (a) There will be elected annually from the users of a domestic water system a committee called the Water Board, consisting of two members, who shall be responsible for the maintenance of the system and the collection of water rates.
- (b) No person shall destroy or injure any part of a water system within the Reserve.
- (c) Every householder shall pay to the Water Board the sum of the (8/0.00) Dollars every calendar year.
- (d) Any person who violates any of the provisions of this by-law

shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding ten dollars or imprisonment for a term not exceeding seven days, or both fine and imprisonment.
