## YOURDE HEADTH INDIAN ACTIVOY

## CATPRILL RIVER BAND BYLAUS

The Council of the Campbell River Band of Indians at a meeting held on January 8, 1955 makes the following bylaw pursuant to paragraph (n) and (r) of section 90 of the Indian Act.

## Bylaw To. 5

A bylaw to provide for the regulation of the conduct and activities of hawkers, peddlers or others who enter the Campbell River Reserve, in the Trovince of British Columbia, to ouy or sell or otherwise deal in wares or merchandise.

- (a) To hawker, peddler or other person who enters the reserve to buy, sell or otherwise deal in wares or merchandise, who so from place to place or to other mens houses on foct or with any animal or bicycle, motor cycle, automobile or other vehicle bearing or drawing any goods, wares or merchandise for sale shall buy, sell or otherwise deal in such wares or merchandise without permission in writing therefor of the Council of the Band or the Chief therof.
- (b) Any person who violates any of the provisions of this bylaw shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding ten dellars or imprisonment for a term not exceeding seven days, or both fine and imprisonment.
