

BY-LAW

The Council of the Roseau River Band of Indians at a meeting held...August 11th, 1967.....makes the following By-Law pursuant to paragraph (b) and (i) of Section 80 of the Indian Act.  
By-Law No.

A By-Law to provide for the regulation of traffic on the Roseau River Reserve No. 2 and the Roseau Rapids Reserve No. 2A in the Province of Manitoba.

1. No vehicle shall be operated at a speed in excess of 30 miles an hour on the Roseau River Reserve No. 2 or the Roseau Rapids Reserve No. 2A.
2. Notwithstanding the provisions of Section 1, a vehicle shall not be operated on a playground area or driven at a rate of speed in excess of 15 miles an hour within any playground area designated and marked as such by the Council of the Band.
3. Any person who violates any of the provisions of the By-Law shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding One hundred dollars (\$100.00) or imprisonment for a term not exceeding thirty (30) days, or both fine and imprisonment.

DO HEREBY RESOLVE:

Whereas the Council of the Roseau River Band of Indians has agreed to administer, manage, and put into effect certain projects and programs for the benefit and well being of the members of the Roseau River Band of Indians;

And whereas the Department of Indian Affairs and Northern Development has agreed, pursuant to their program generally known as "Grants to Bands", to turn over to the Council of the Roseau River Band of Indians certain funds for the purpose of underwriting part or all of the costs of the said programs and projects;

And whereas it is expedient and in the best interests of the members of the Roseau River Band of Indians to ensure that the programs and projects are administered, and the funds are expended in an efficient manner;

Now therefore the Council of the Roseau River Band of Indians enacts as a by-law thereof, pursuant to Section 80(q) of the Indian Act, the following:

1. The Administrative and Financial Regulations dated November 24, 1971, attached hereto and marked Appendix 'A' (which regulations are deemed to be and form part of this by-law) be and the same are hereby approved and adopted.
2. Those Regulations shall come into force and take effect on the twenty-fourth day of November, 1971.
