

The Council of the Fairford Band of Indians at a meeting held 1950 24/59 (date), makes the following by-law pursuant to paragraph (b) and (r) of section 80 of The Indian Act.

By-law No. 1

A by-law to provide for the regulation of traffic in the Fairford Indian Reserve, in the Province of Manitoba.

- (a) No vehicle shall be operated at a rate of speed in excess of 30 miles an hour on any road within the Fairford Indian Reserve.
- (b) Notwithstanding the provisions of paragraph (a) no vehicle shall be operated at a rate of speed in excess of 15 miles an hour within any school area designated and marked as such by the council of the Band.
- (c) Any person who violates any of the provisions of this by-law shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding ten dollars or imprisonment for a term not exceeding seven days, or both fine and imprisonment.
