LITTLE GRAND RAPIDS FIRST NATION By-Law No.

BEING A BY-LAW RESPECTING THE PROHIBATION AGAINST THE USE OF INTOXICANTS WHICH INCLUDES THE INHALATION OF SOLVENTS AND GASOLINE VAPOURS

WHEREAS the Council of the Little Grand Rapids First Nation may make by-laws relating to intoxicants on the reserve;

AND WHEREAS a majority of the electors of the Band at a special meeting called to consider the By-Law voted in favor of it;

AND WHEREAS paragraph 81(1), (a), (c), (d), (q) and (r) of the <u>Indian Act</u>, R.S.C. 1985, c. I-5, empower, the Council of a Band to make by-laws to provide for the health of residents, the obervance of law and order, the prevention of disorderly conduct and nuisances, with respect to any matter arising out of or ancillary to the exercise of powers under section 81, and the imposition on summary conviction of a fine or imprisonment for violation thereof;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Little Grand Rapids First Nation enacts as a By-Law as follows

Interpretation

1. In this By-Law;

"Intoxicated" means being under the influence of an intoxicating matter or vapour to the extent that a person's physical and mental functioning is impaired;

"Intoxicated matter" includes plastic solvents, adhesive cement, cleaning agents, glue, dope, nail polish remover, lighter fluid, gasoline, paint or lacquer thinner, or any other substance which indicates a state of impairment,

"Intoxicating vapour" means any vapour, fume or liquid that is emitted or produced from an intoxicating matter.

Any person who has voluntarily inhaled or introduced into his respiratory system an intoxicant or seeks to induce another to do so is guilty of an offence.

Any person who is guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding \$ 1000.00 or to imprisonment for a term not exceeding 6 months or to both.

Exceptions	
2. Sections do	not apply to any person who:
(a) manufactures or sells an intoxic	cating matter for medical purposes;
(b) inhales administers or otherwis system under the supervision of a	se introduces an intoxicating vapour into his respiratory physician or dentist, or
