BY_LAW

The Council of the Hollow Water Band of Indians at a meeting held November 21, 1963 makes the following by-law pursuant to paragraph (b) and (i) of Section 80 of the Indian Act.

By-Law No./

A by-law to provide for the regulation of traffic in the Hole or Hollow Water River Indian Reserve No. 10, in the Province of Manitoba.

- 1. No vehicle shall be operated at a speed in excess of 30 miles an hour on the Hole or Hollow Water River Indian Reserve No. 10.
- 2. Notwithstanding the provisions of Section 1, a vehicle shall not be operated at a rate of speed in excess of 15 miles an hour within any school zone designated and marked as such by the Council of the Band.
- 3. Any person who violates any of the provisions of the by-law shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding one hundred dollars or imprisonment for a term not exceeding thirty days, or both fine and imprisonment.
