DO HEREBY RESOLVE:

That we make the following by-law pursuant to paragraphs (b) and (r) of Section 80 of the Indian Act.

By-law number 1.

A By-law to provide for the regulation of traffic in the Lake St. Martin Indian Reserve, in the Province of Manitoba.

- (a) No vehicle shall be operated at a rate of speed in excess of 30 miles an hour on any road within the Lake St. Martin Indian Reserve.
- (b) Notwithstanding the provisions of paragraph (a), no vehicle shall be operated at a rate of speed in excess of 15 miles per hour within any school area designated and marked as such by the Council of the Band.

Any person who violates any of the provisions of this by-law shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding Ten Dollars (\$10.00) or imprisonment for a term not exceeding seven days, or both fine and imprisonment.

THE LAKE ST. MARTIN BAND OF INDIANS

BY-LAW NO. 1-73

Being a by-law for the removal and punishment of persons who trespass or frequent the Reserve for purposes not conducive to the well-being of the Reserve inhabitants.

WHEREAS Paragraphs (p) and (r) of Section 80 of the Indian Act empower the Band Council to make by-laws respecting the removal and punishment of persons trespassing upon the Reserve or frequenting the Reserve for prescribed purposes and the imposition of a penalty for the violation thereof;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient to limit the access of certain undesirable persons for the protecting and well being of the Reserve Residents of the Lake St. Martin Indian Reserve.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Lake St. Martin Band of Indians enacts the following by-law:

- (1) In this by-law,
 - (a) "Council" means the Council, as defined in the Indian Act, of the Lake St. Martin Band of Indians.
 - (b) "Reserve" means the tract of land set apart by Her Majesty within the definition of the Indian Act, for the use and benefit of the Lake St. Martin Indian Band.
 - (c) "Trespass" means to enter unlawfully upon the Lake St. Martin Indian Reserve after notice of trespassing has been served.
- (2) The notice of trespassing shall be served by registered mail and/or delivered by hand to those persons who in the opinion of the Lake St. Martin Band Council are undesirable, and found to be trespassing.
- (3) Any person who violates any provision of this by-law shall be guilty of an offense and shall be liable to a fine not exceeding one hundred dollars or imprisonment for a term not exceeding thirty days, or both fine and imprisonment.

Approved and passed at a duly convened meeting of the Council this 9th day of Feb. 1973.
