The Council of the Ebb & Flow Band of Indians at a meeting held Cctober 14, 1964, , makes the following By-law pursuant to Paragraphs (b) and (r) of Section 80 of The Indian Act.

BY-LAW NO. 1

A By-law to provide for the regulation of traffic on the Ebb & Flow Indian Reserve No. 52, in the Province of Manitoba.

No vehicle shall be operated at a rate of speed in excess of thirty
(3) miles an hour within the Reserve.

Notwithstanding the provisions of Section 1 of this By-law no vehicle shall be operated at a rate of speed in excess of fifteen (15) miles an hour within any school zone in the Reserve designated and marked as such by the Council.

3. Any person who violates any of the provisions of this By-law shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding twenty-five dollars or imprisonment for a term not exceeding thirty days, or both fine and imprisonment.
