

THE BAND OF INDIANS.  
BY-LAW NO.

Being a by-law to establish Administrative  
and Financial Regulations

WHEREAS the Council of the *Sirdtail* Band of Indians has agreed to administer, manage, and put into effect certain projects and programs for the benefit and well being of the members of the *Sirdtail* Band of Indians;

AND WHEREAS the Department of Indian Affairs and Northern Development has agreed, pursuant to their program generally known as "Grants to Bands", to turn over to the Council of the *Sirdtail* Band of Indians certain funds for the purpose of underwriting part or all of the costs of the said programs and projects;

AND WHEREAS it is expedient and in the best interests of the members of the *Sirdtail* Band of Indians to ensure that the programs and projects are administered, and the funds are expended in an efficient manner;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the *Sirdtail* Band of Indians enacts as a by-law thereof, pursuant to Section 80(q) of the Indian Act, the following:

1. The Administrative and Financial Regulations dated 1971, attached hereto and marked Appendix 'A' (which regulations are deemed to be and form part of this by-law) be and the same are hereby approved and adopted.

2. These Regulations shall come into force and take effect on the *First* day of *April*, 1971.
