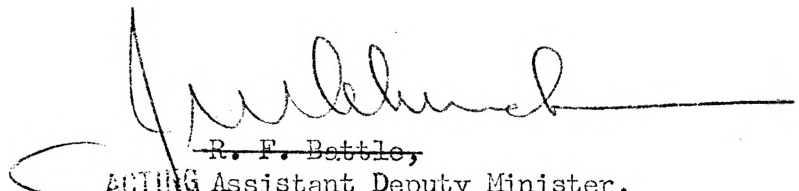

By-law No. 1 - To provide for the
regulation of traffic in
the Devon Indian Reserve
No. 30 in the province of
New Brunswick.

The Council of the St. Mary's Band of Indians at a meeting held this 25th day of April, 1967, makes the following bylaw pursuant to paragraph (b) and (r) of section 80 of The Indian Act.

Bylaw No. 1

A bylaw to provide for the regulation of traffic in the Devon Indian Reserve, in the Province of New Brunswick.

- (a) No vehicle shall be operated at a rate of speed in excess of 20 miles an hour within any residential area designated and marked as such by the council of the band.
- (b) No vehicle shall be operated over any bridge within the Devon Indian Reserve at a rate of speed in excess of the speed designated and marked thereon by the council of the band.
- (c) Any person who violates any of the provisions of this bylaw shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding ten dollars or imprisonment for a term not exceeding seven days, or both fine and imprisonment.
