

To revoke By-Law No. 1-85

WHEREAS Section 85.1 of the Indian Act (Revised June 28, 1985) empowers the Council of a band to make By-laws respecting the regulation of Intoxicants on an Indian Reserve.

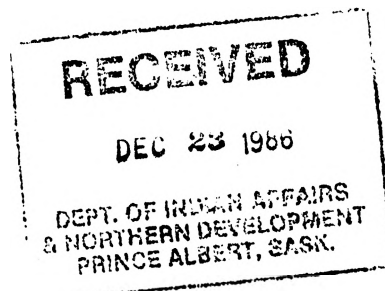
WHEREAS the Council of the Red Earth Band of Indians enacted a By-law to provide regulations for the control of intoxicants on the reserve consistent with the requirements as outlined in Section 85(1) of the Indian Act (Revised June 28, 1985).

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Red Earth Band of Indians enacts as a By-Law the following.

In this By-Law

1. Council means the Council of the Red Earth Band of Indians.
2. Reserve means Red Earth Reserve #29.
3. The Council of the Red Earth Band of Indians hereby revoke By-Law 1-85 being a By-law respecting sale, barter or supply of intoxicants on the Reserve.
