## REGULATION OF TRAFFIC8

The Council of the Thunderchild Band of Indians at a meeting held May 25th, 1966, makes the following by-law pursuant to paragraph (b) and (r) of Section 80 of the Indian Act.

By-lav No. l...
A by-law to provide for the regulation of traffic in Thunderchild Indian Reserves 115B and 115C, in the Province of Saskatchewan.
(a) No vehicle shall be operated at a rate of speed in excess of thirty-five milos an hour within the boundaries of designated reserves.
(b) No vehicle shall be operated at a rate of speed in excess of twenty miles, an hour within the school zones of the Thunderchild Indian Reserves $115 B$ and 1150 designated and marked as such by the Council of the Band.
(c) Notwithstanding above sub-sections (a) and (b), the Band Council may in the public interest, fix a maximu speed on the reserve roads or portions thereof and shall cause to be erected at each end of the reserve roads or portions thereof and at intervals along the roadways or portions thereof signs indicating such maximum speeds. No.person shall drive a motor which on such roadways or portions thereof upon which such signs have been erected, at a speed greater than that so indicated.
(d) Any person who violates any of the provisions of this by-law shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding one hundred dollars ( $\$ 100.00$ ) or imprisonment for a term not exceeding thirty days, or both fine and imprisonment.
