DO HEREBY RESOLVE:

REGULATION OF TRAFFIC:

The Council of the Mosquito-G.B.H. Band of Indians at a meeting held May 27, 1966, make the following by-law pursuant to paragraph (b) and (r) of Section 80 of the Indian Act.

By-law No. 1.

A by-law to provide for the regulation of traffic in Mosquito-G.B.H., and Lean Man Reserves Nos. 109, 110, and 111 in the Province of Saskatchewan.

- (a) For this By-law "Road" and "Vehicle" are as defined in sub-section (a) and (b) in Section 3 of the Indian Reserve Traffic Regulations.
- (b) No vehicle shall be operated at a rate of speed in excess of thirty miles an hour within the boundaries of designated reserves.
- (c) No vehicle shall be operated at a rate of speed in excess of fifteen miles an hour within the school zones of the Mosquito Reserve No. 109 designated and marked as such by the Council of the Band.
- (d) Notwithstanding above sub-sections (a) and (b), the Band Council may in the public interest fix a maximum speed on the reserve roads or portions thereof and shall cause to be erected at each end of the reserve roads or portions thereof and at intervals along the roadways as portions thereof signs indicating such maximum speeds. No person shall drive a motor which on such roadways or portions thereof upon which such signs have been erected, at a greater speed than so indicated.
- (e) Any person who violates any of the provision of this by-law shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding one-hundred (\$100.00) or imprisonment for a term not exceeding thirty days, or both fine and imprisonment.
