Notice is hereby given that the Council of the Maria Mic-Mac Band of Indians at a meeting held this 27th day of April 1977 Make the following by-law pursuant to paragraph (c) (d) (m)(r) of Section 81 of the Indian Act as amended.

By-law #2

Article 1

No boy or girl on the said Indian Reserve who is 16 years or under shall loiter in any place on the Reserve, after 9 o'clock in the evening during the school season. And not after 10 P.M. during the vacation months.

Article 2

No boy or girl who is 16 or under shall be in any place of entertainment, street or by way within the Reserve or shall be in the course of returning from any place of entertainment of the said Reserve after the hours of 9 and 10 in the evening, Unless he or she is accompanied by his or her parents. Or an adult appointed by a parent to accompany such child.

Article 3

A boy or girl on the said Reserve found violating this provisions 1&2 will be warned and escorted home by a Police Officer.

Article 4

A parent who permits his or her child to violate these provisions shall be guilty of an offence and be liable on summary conviction to a fine of \$10.00 or imprisonment of a term not exceeding 7 days.
