AMENDMENT TO BY-LAW #3

ADOPTED

SECTION 1: will now read

For interpretation of the present by-law, unless otherwise expressed, the following words and expressions:

- 1) "Competent authority" means the Band Council, a peace officer of the River Desert Police Department, or all other persons legally authorized by the Band Council.
- 2) "Police Chief" means the Chief Police Officer of the River Desert Police Department on the River Desert Indian Reserve.
- 3) "Policeman" means a member of the River Desert Police Department.
- 4) "Reserve" means the River Desert Indian Reserve No. 18.
- 5) "Vehicle or motor vehicle" signifies all vehicles powered by other than muscular force and adapted for transportation on public roadways, however, not on rails. It includes as private vehicles, farm vehicles, business vehicles, and motorcycles and as public vehicles, buses, taxis, delivery vehicles and emergency vehicles.
- 6) "Emergency vehicles" means a vehicle identified as a Police, Fire, Ambulance or civil protection vehicle.
- 7) "Public roadway, street, road" means a roadway, street or trail open to public circulation.

SECTION 49: will now read

It is strictly forbidden to drive at a speed exceeding the limit set and posted by competent authority.

SECTION 72: will now read

Section 73 - Fine of \$200.00
Section 74 - Fine of \$25.00
Section 75 - Fine of \$50.00
Section 76 - Fine of \$100.00

SECTION 73:

All speeds and dangerous actions susceptible to endanger public security, life or property are prohibited on the roadways of the Reserve.

SECTION 74:

It is strictly forbidden to consume any alcoholic beverages in a motor vehicle, this section applies not only to the driver but to passengers also.

SECTION 75:


It is strictly forbidden to abandon a motor vehicle on the roadways of the reserve.

SECTION 76:

It is strictly forbidden to leave the scene of an accident without first offering assistance to injured people involved and second, identifying yourself to the other party.

the River Desert Indian Band.
