() he recommission whall accumulate or permit to be accumulated upon I has in his somession or deposit or accumulate on the lyards in possession of mother region anything which is or may become

offensive or injurious to health.

(i) its error right deposit any dead animal, offal, fish, manure, partice, fruit, vegatables, right-soil, filth, liquid taste, or mything of a mature which is or may become offensive or a judicial to health upon or into any highway, street, road, alley, lane, lot, ditch, wharf both, lake, bond, river, stream, well, or sewer, or into any land or premises within the reserve and any such deposit shall be deemed a muisance, provided, herever, that the provistions of this paragraph shall not apply to the deposit and proper disposal of any such materia into or at a place within the reserve approved by the Council for that purpose.

(c) The Council may arrange for the regular removal of garbage and waste from any premises

tithin the reserve.

(3) In the opring of each year as soon as the melting of snow permits the person in possession of any promises within the reserve shall collect all waste matter lying thereon including tin c ns, bottles, paper and animal manure.

(c) All such waste matter shall be disposed of in such a manner as will prevent any nuisance or

offence as the fouling of wells and water supply.

(f) ing person the violates any of the provisions of this By-law shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding ten dollars or imprisonment for a term not exceeding seven days, or both fine and imprisonment.

The Council of the Kingschear Band will arrange for the regular removal of garbage and waste at a cost to the householder of seventy-five cents per week per household.
