THE SARCEE BAND OF INDIANS

BY-LAW NUMBER 3

Being a By-Law of the Sarcee Band of  
Indians to Control and Regulate the Use of  
Firearms on the Sarcee Reserve

WHEREAS paragraphs (c), (d) and (r) of Section 81 of  
the Indian Act empower the Council of a Band to make By-Laws  
respecting the carrying and discharge of firearms and the imposition  
of a penalty for the violation thereof.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Sarcee Band of Indians  
enacts as a by-law thereon as follows:

1. This By-Law may be cited as a "Sarcee Indian Reserve  
Weapons By-Law".
2. In this By-Law
  - (1) "Weapon" Means any firearm, air gun or air pistol.
  - (2) "Constable" means a person appointed by the Council  
of the Band to carry out and enforce such duties as  
are assigned to him.
  - (3) "Sarcee Village" means that portion of the Sarcee  
Indian Reserve Number 145 as shown on the attached  
Plan to this By-Law.

DANGEROUS PRACTICES

3. No person shall
  - (a) carry any firearm, air gun, air pistol or pellet  
gun within the Sarcee Village,
  - (b) shall discharge any firearm, air gun, air pistol  
or pellet gun within the Sarcee Village unless

specially authorized by the Constable.

PENALTIES

4. (1) A person guilty of an infraction of this By-Law either in doing something which is prohibited by a provision of this By-Law or by refusing, neglecting or failing to do something which he is required to do by a provision hereof is guilty of an offence, and is liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding the maximum of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) for which he is convicted and to costs; or in default of payment of such fine and costs to imprisonment not exceeding thirty (30) days.

5. This By-Law repeals all previously enacted Sarcee Band Council By-Laws insofar as weapons on the Sarcee Indian Reserve No. 145 is concerned.
