

By-Law # 1  
June 27, 1957

The Council of the Paul's Band of Indians at a meeting held on June 27, 1957, on the Wabamun Reserve makes the following by-law pursuant to paragraph (b) and (r) of section 80 of the Indian Act.

By-law No. 1

A by-law to provide for the regulation of traffic in the Wabamun Indian Reserve, in the Province of Alberta.

- (a) No vehicle shall be operated at a rate of speed in excess of thirty miles an hour within any part of the Wabamun Indian Reserve No. 133A.
- (b) No vehicle shall be operated at a rate of speed in excess of fifteen miles per hour within any residential area or school zone designated and marked as such by the council of the band.
- (c) Any person who violates any of the provisions of this by-law shall be guilty of an offense and shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding ten dollars, or imprisonment for a term not exceeding seven days, or both fine and imprisonment.
