By-law No. 4

A by-law to provide for the regulation of driving licensing on the Indian Reserves of

1. In this by-law

(a) "Council" means the Council of the Slaves of Upper Hay River Band of Indians;

(b) "Reserve" means Indian Reserves

No. 213 Bistcho Lake
No. 214 Jackfish Point;

(c) "vehicle" means any wagon, cart, motor car, motor truck, trailer, motorcycle, traction engine, tractor, road-making machinery, power toboggan or other conveyance that is driven, propelled or drawn by any kind of power.
