The First Nations Tax Commission, pursuant to the *First Nations*Fiscal Management Act, hereby approves the following law made by the Squamish Nation in the Province of British Columbia,

Squamish Nation Annual Expenditure Amendment Law, 2015

SQUAMISH NATION ANNUAL EXPENDITURE AMENDMENT LAW, 2015

WHEREAS:

- A. Council of the Squamish Nation enacted the Squamish Nation Annual Expenditure Law, 2015; and
- B. A supplementary assessment roll was later completed, resulting in additional revenue.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Squamish Nation duly enacts as follows:

- 1. This Law may be cited as the Squamish Nation Annual Expenditure Amendment Law, 2015.
- 2. In this Law:
 - "Act" means the First Nations Fiscal Management Act, S.C. 2005, c.9, and the regulations made under that Act; and
 - "Annual Expenditure Law" means the Squamish Nation Annual Expenditure Law, 2015.
- 3. The First Nation's annual budget for the year beginning January 1, 2015, and ending December 31, 2015, and interim budget for the year beginning January 1, 2016, and ending December 31, 2016, attached as Schedule 1 to the Annual Expenditure Law is hereby repealed and replaced with the amended annual budget for the year beginning January 1, 2015, and ending December 31, 2015, and interim budget for the year beginning January 1, 2016, and ending December 31, 2016, attached as Schedule 1 to this Law.
- 4. The Schedule attached to this Law forms part of and is an integral part of this Law.
- 5. This Law comes into force and effect on the day after it is approved by the First Nations Tax Commission.
