**LITTLE SHUSWAP LAKE FIRST NATION**

**BY-LAW NO. 2015-T02**

**ANNUAL RATES BY-LAW**

WHEREAS pursuant to the *Indian Act*, R.S.C. 1985, and specifically paragraph 83(1)(a) of the *Indian Act*, 1985, c.I-5, the Council of a band may make by-laws for the purpose of taxation for local purposes of land, or interests in land, including rights to occupy, possess or use land in a reserve and with respect to any matters arising out of or ancillary to such purpose;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Little Shuswap Lake First Nation (also known as the Little Shuswap Lake Indian Band) enacted the *Little Shuswap Lake First Nation Property Assessment and Taxation By-law* on November 30th , 1995 ;

NOW BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the following by-law be and is hereby enacted pursuant to the provisions of the *Indian Act*, and in particular section 83(1) for the purpose of establishing annual rates of taxation.


1. This by-law may be cited for all purposes as the *Little Shuswap Lake First Nation Rates By-law 2015.*
2. Pursuant to Section 18.1 of the *Little Shuswap Lake First Nation Property Assessment and Taxation By-law*, the tax rates for each class of property shall be in accordance with Schedule "A" which is attached, and forms part of the 2015 Rates By-law.

THIS BY-LAW IS HEREBY DULY ENACTED by Council on the 15th day of July, 2015, at Squilax, in the Province of British Columbia.
