Dene Tha' First Nation; and.

WHEREAS:

The duly elected Chief and Council representing the Dene Tha' First Nation, have met at a duly convened

meeting held in Bushe River, Alberta on this 22nd day of July, 2013; and

WHEREAS

Pursuant to subsection 83(1)(a) of the *Indian Act*, R.S.C. 1985, c.I-5, the Council of a Band may make by-laws for the purpose of taxation for local purposes of land, or interests in land, including rights to occupy, possess or use land in a Reserve and with respect to any matters arising out of or ancillary to

such purpose;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Dene Tha' First Nation enacted the Dene Tha' Property Assessment and Taxation Bylaw on December 14, 1999;

NOW BE IT THEREBY RESOLVED that the following by-law be and is hereby enacted pursuant to the provisions of the Indian Act and in particular section 83(1) for the purpose of establishing annual rates of taxation

1. This by-law may be cited for all purposes as the Dene Tha' First Nation Tax Rates By-law 2013.

Pursuant to section 11 of the Dene Tha' Property Assessment and Taxation By-Law, the rate of tax applied 2. against the assessed value of property shall be,

a) for non-residential

1.80%

b) for machinery and equipment

1.30%
