TAXATION BY-LAW

TL'AZT'EN NATION 2006 EXPENDITURE BY-LAW

WHEREAS pursuant to subsection 83(1)(a)) of the *Indian Act*, the Council of a band may make bylaws for the purpose of taxation for local purposes of land, or interests in land, including rights to occupy, possess or use land in a reserve and with respect to any matter arising out of or ancillary to such purpose; and,

WHEREAS the Council of the Tl'azt'en Nation enacted the Tl'azt en Nation Property Assessment and Taxation By-law on the 25th day of October 1996;

NOW BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the following by-law be and is hereby enacted pursuant to the provisions of the *Indian Act* and in particular Section 55(3) and Section 56 for the purpose of the application of taxation revenues.

- 1. This bylaw may be cited for all purposes as the Tl'azt en Nation 2006 Expenditure By-law.
- Pursuant to Section 55 and 56 of the Tl'azt'en Nation Property Assessment and Taxation By-law, the expenditures of faxation revenues are as follows:
 - (a) the administration of the Tl'azt'en Nation Property Assessment and Taxation By-law, \$2,000.00;
 - (b) the renumeration of British Columbia Assessment Authority, \$974.24

This by-law is hereby enacted by Council at a duly convened meeting held in Tache, B.C. on the 28th day of June, 2006.
