**ST. MARY'S INDIAN BAND  
PROPERTY ASSESSMENT AMENDMENT LAW, 2008-02**

WHEREAS:

A. Pursuant to section 5 of the *First Nations Fiscal and Statistical Management Act*, the Council of the St. Mary's Indian Band enacted the *St. Mary's Indian Band Property Assessment Law, 2008*, which came into force on September 18, 2008;

B. The Council of the St. Mary's Indian Band deems it to be in the best interests of the St. Mary's Indian Band to amend that law; and

C. Pursuant to subsections 6(2) and 8(2) of the *First Nations Fiscal and Statistical Management Act*, the First Nations Tax Commission has the discretion to exempt St. Mary's Indian Band from the requirements under subsections 6(1) and 8(1) of that Act with respect to the amendments herein;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the St. Mary's Indian Band, at a duly convened meeting, enacts as follows:

1. This Law may be cited as the *St. Mary's Indian Band Property Assessment Amendment Law, 2008-02*.

2. Subsection 29(2) of the *St. Mary's Indian Band Property Assessment Law, 2008* is hereby amended by deleting it in its entirety and replacing it with the following:

(2) The address for delivery of a Notice of Appeal to the assessor is:

3. This Law comes into force and effect on the day after it is approved by the First Nations Tax Commission.

THIS LAW IS HEREBY DULY ENACTED by Council at a duly convened meeting held on the 26<sup>th</sup> day of November, 2008, in the Ktunaxa Nation Territory.

A quorum of Council consists of three (3) members of Council.
