RATES BY-LAW

By-Law No. 01-2005

WHEREAS pursuant to the *Indian Act*, R.S.C. 1985, and specifically paragraph 83(1)(a) of the Indian Act, 1985, c.I-5, the Council of a band may make by-laws for the purpose of taxation for local purposes of land, or interests in land, including rights to occupy, possess or use land in a reserve and with respect to any matters arising out of or ancillary to such purpose;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Williams Lake Indian Band (also known as Williams Lake First Nation) enacted the Williams Lake Indian Band Property Assessment and Taxation By-law on February 3, 2004;

NOW BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the following by-law be and is hereby enacted pursuant to the provisions of the *Indian Act*, and in particular section 83(1) for the purpose of establishing annual rates of taxation.

- This by-law may be cited for all purposes as the Williams Lake Indian Band 2005 Rates Bylaw.
- Pursuant to Section 11 of the Williams Lake Indian Band Property Assessment and Taxation By-law, the tax rates for each class of property shall be in accordance with Schedule "A" which is attached, and forms part of the 2005 Rates By-law.
