TAX RATES BYLAW 2010

WHEREAS pursuant to subsection 83(1)(a) of the *Indian Act*, R.S.C., the Council of a band may make bylaws for the purpose of taxation for local purposes of land, or interests in land, including rights to occupy, possess or use land in a reserve and with respect to any matters arising out of or ancillary to such purpose;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Boston Bar First Nation enacted the Boston Bar First Nation Assessment and Taxation Bylaws (2004) on October 16, 2004, approved by the Minister December 20, 2004.

NOW BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the following "Schedule A", enacted for the purpose of establishing annual rates of taxation, is hereby adopted and approved as the Boston Bar First Nation Tax Rates Bylaw 2010.
